Anti-Discrimination Services

Here are some contact points for individuals who experience discrimination based on various factors. These services are available for FLINTA* individuals as well as for male-identifying individuals and (cis) men.

1. General Anti-Discrimination Services

a. Anti-Discrimination Network Berlin (ADNB) of the TBB

- **Description**: The network offers support for all individuals who have experienced discrimination. The focus is on discrimination based on ethnicity or religion.
- Target Group: People with a history of migration or refugee
- Services: Legal support, psychosocial counseling
- Website: TBB ADNB

b. ReachOut Berlin

- **Description**: ReachOut supports people affected by racist, far-right, or anti-Semitic violence.
- Target Group: All people affected by racist and far-right violence.
- **Services**: Psychosocial counseling, accompaniment to authorities and court proceedings, public relations.

c. OFEK e.V.

- **Description**: OFEK offers counseling for people affected by anti-Semitic discrimination and violence.
- Target Group: Jewish people and those affected by anti-Semitism.
- Services: Individual counseling, prevention, legal counseling.

2. Counseling Services for Gender-Based Violence and Sexual Assault

These services provide support for people of all genders, including men and male-identifying individuals, who have experienced gender-based violence or assault.

a. Wildwasser Berlin e.V.

- **Description**: Originally founded as a contact point for women, Wildwasser now offers counseling services for trans*, inter*, and non-binary individuals who have experienced sexualized violence.
- Target Group: FLINTA*
- **Services**: Counseling, crisis intervention, therapeutic support.

b. Tauwetter e.V. – Contact Point for Men Who Have Experienced Sexualized Violence

- **Description**: Tauwetter offers specific support for men who have experienced sexualized violence. The service is available for both cis and trans* men and provides a safe space for processing abuse experiences.
- Target Group: Men and male-identifying individuals.
- **Services**: Individual counseling, self-help groups, crisis intervention.

c. Berlin Crisis Service

- Description: The Berlin Crisis Service provides support for individuals in acute crisis situations. They offer decentralized services, so people can find help quickly in their area.
- Target Group: All individuals in crisis situations.
- **Services**: Telephone counseling, on-site crisis intervention, support for psychosocial emergencies.

3. Queer and FLINTA-Specific Services, Open to Male-Identifying Individuals and Men

a. Queer Leben

- Description: Queer Leben offers counseling and therapy services for the entire LGBTQIA+ community.
- Target Group: LGBTQIA+
- Services: Counseling for coming out, psychosocial support, couples counseling.
- Website: Queer Leben

b. GLADT e.V.

- **Description**: GLADT focuses on BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color), queer individuals, and people with a history of migration. They offer counseling in various languages and work intersectionally.
- Target Group: Queer individuals affected by racism.
- Services: Psychosocial counseling, empowerment workshops, legal support.

c. Maneo - Gay Anti-Violence Project

- **Description**: Maneo is an anti-violence project focused on men who have been discriminated against or attacked because of their sexuality. They offer psychosocial counseling, crisis intervention, and support in cases of violence.

- **Services**: Crisis intervention, legal counseling, accompaniment during court proceedings.

4. Anti-Racist and Community-Based Counseling Services

a. Each One Teach One (EOTO) e.V.

- **Description**: EOTO is an organization that advocates for BIPOC in Berlin and offers educational programs, empowerment workshops, and counseling.

b. KOP - Campaign for Victims of Racial Police Violence

- **Description**: KOP supports all individuals who have experienced racist police violence. They offer legal counseling and guide people affected through the legal process.

5. Psychosocial and Legal Support

a. Befreit Euch! - Contact Point for Migrants Affected by Violence

- **Description**: This counseling center is for people with a history of migration who have experienced violence. It offers a safe space for psychosocial and legal support.
- Target Group: Individuals with a migration background.
- Services: Crisis intervention, counseling, networking with specialized organizations.

b. Men's Counseling Berlin - Violence Prevention

- **Description**: This counseling service provides specific support for men who have become victims of violence or seek help in managing aggression. There is a particular focus on gender-based violence, but offender work is also offered.
